Program Reporting Requirements:

Background

Home and community care nursing services are critical for care, treatment and support, secondary and tertiary prevention of diabetes, and home care services are an important part of FNIHB’s response to chronic disease management. To ensure the highest quality care possible, home and community care nurses require expanded training in clinical practice guidelines and chronic disease management strategies to provide the increasingly complex care that is being delivered to diabetes patients in their homes and communities. The First Nations and Inuit Home and Community Care (FNIHCC) program data indicate that approximately 80% of the 25,000 clients have one or more chronic illness, and that diabetes is the primary reason for HCC services. The FNIHCC summative evaluation (2009) recommended improved quality client care and ongoing training support to HCC care providers. The intent and overall objective of the new funding is to provide training, both in person and remotely, for home and community care nurses on the most current best practices and clinical practice guidelines in the treatment and the prevention of complications of diabetes and other chronic diseases.
