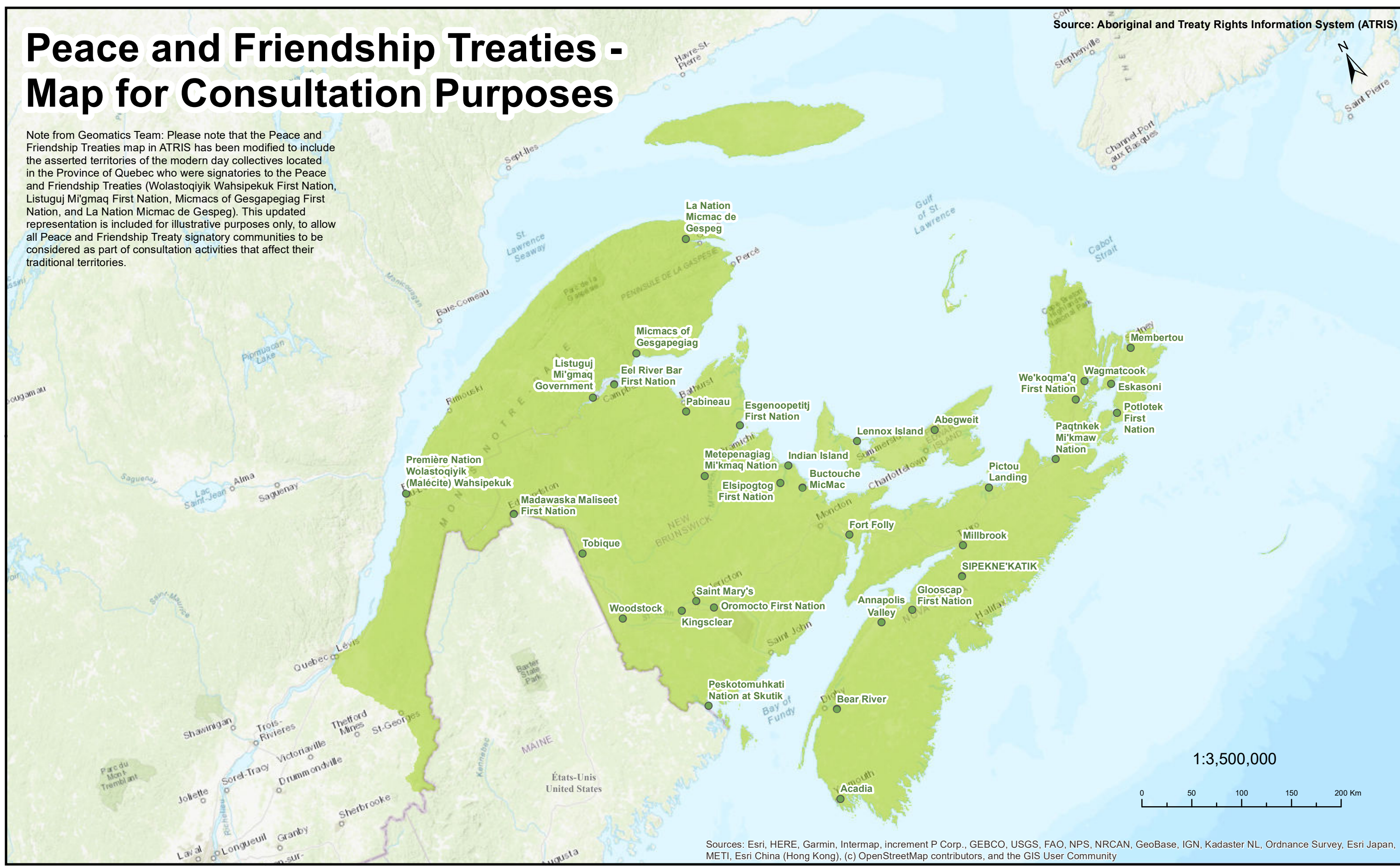




# Peace and Friendship Treaties - Map for Consultation Purposes

Note from Geomatics Team: Please note that the Peace and Friendship Treaties map in ATRIS has been modified to include the asserted territories of the modern day collectives located in the Province of Quebec who were signatories to the Peace and Friendship Treaties (Wolastoqiyik Wahsipekuk First Nation, Listuguj Mi'gmaq First Nation, Micmacs of Gesgapegiag First Nation, and La Nation Micmac de Gespeg). This updated representation is included for illustrative purposes only, to allow all Peace and Friendship Treaty signatory communities to be considered as part of consultation activities that affect their traditional territories.
