Program reporting requirements:

The recipient shall submit to the minister, the eHealth Program (e-Health) Year-End Report, which should describe the activities undertaken and the progress made towards achieving project objectives, including any relevant financial information. The report should also include, but is not limited to, the following information:

- Connectivity speed and the specific type of connectivity infrastructure (e.g., fiber, satellite, other) for the health facility;
- Name of application/tool/system and number of sites using: (i.e., public health surveillance system (i.e., Panorama); Electronic Medical Record (EMR); Electronic Health Record (EHR); other eHealth tools);
- Number of communities visited and the status of eHealth in those communities;
- Presentations completed, meetings attended; and
- Other activities undertaken relative to eHealth.

If telehealth services are offered, state the following:

- The number of sites; and
- Utilization rate including number and type of clinical, patient education, professional development/training, and administrative telehealth sessions.
